

#### **SYNOPSIS**



Other credits include AN INVISIBLE SIGN OF MY OWN, THE LIFE BEFORE HER EYES, LIFE ON MARS, LAW & ORDER: CI, and Joel on the daytime series AS THE WORLD TURNS.
